SOIL Shell/coral limestone, Opok (a tertiary soil –

clay and marl), thin sandy layer.

VINIFICATION A good wine needs time! Fermented and

aged in oak barrels. After resting on the fine lees for 60 months wine is bottled and brought to the marker 7 years after

the harvest.

CHARACTER Bright goledn yellow. Has notes of nougat,

white peach, orange zest, mango undertones. Full bodied with nice acidity structure. Pure elegance, deeply marked by the limey soil,

while always bright and fine.
